


QUAD LAYOUT



NOTE: if this layout is used with different boxes the back boxes might be able to be shifted closer to the rail.

This is our current layout for a **QUAD** for a typical shortboard. This should be considered a starting point for your own designs. The cluster should be moved forward or back as the length of the board changes. This grouping of the cluster works well as a modern setup, if more stiffness is needed the boxes can be spread further apart, as needed. The back fin placement should be moved further inboard for boards with a straighter outline in the tail (Fish), normally this can range from 1/8" to 1/4". **Cant angles** – FRONT 8° and BACK 4°. Because of the amount of adjustment in the **GB24** boxes the placement has been altered to bring the two boxes closer together. This means that the spread of the fins can be altered by as much as 3/4" / 9.5mm,.
