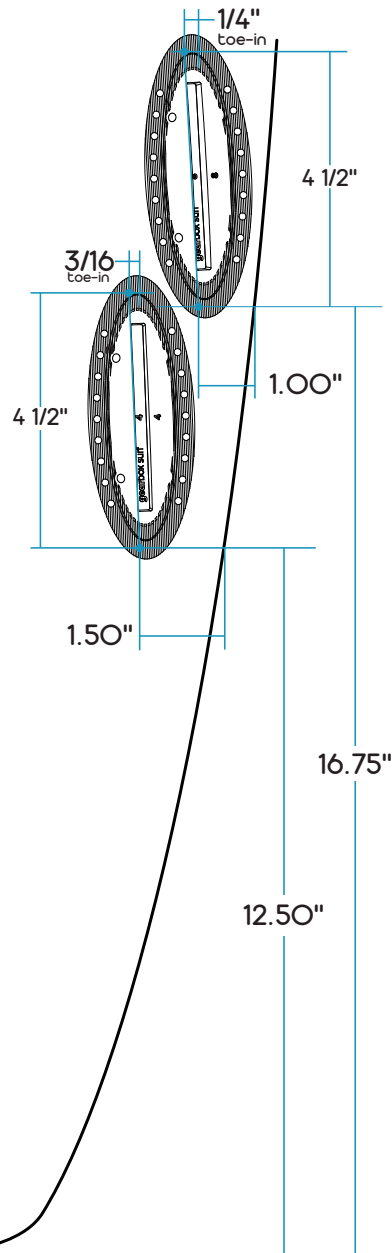


KNEEBOARD QUAD LAYOUT



NOTE: if this layout is used with different boxes the back boxes might be able to be shifted closer to the rail.

This is our layout for a **QUAD** on a kneeboard. Typically, the back fin is placed the same distance in from the rail as the front fin, but on fishes the straighter outline requires the back fin to be shifted in a little more to keep some spread from the front fin. This should be considered a starting point for your own designs. **Cant angles** – FRONT 8° and BACK 4° boxes. Because of the amount of adjustment in the **GBOX** boxes the placement can be altered by as much as 3/4" / 9.5mm., so consider incorporating this into the layout.
